## Historical Interpretation

We base interpretation on primary (first hand) and secondary (second hand) historical sources

## Cause and Consequence

Cause is the source or reason of an event or action while the consequence is that which follows the event or action

## Change and Continuity

We develop an understanding of the idea that some things change while others (old and new) stay the same

## Source and Evidence

A source is a place, person or thing from which something originates.

The evidence is the available facts or information indicating whether a belief is true or valid

## Historical Significance

We choose specific events, people, locations and ideas as being important to us

## Similarity and difference

We compare two or more things – physical objects, ideas or experiences.
