Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to inform you that Year 5 staff have booked a visit to the Safeside event in Birmingham on the following dates:



5NH- Wednesday 15th June

5SW- Thursday 16th June

5SB- Wednesday 29th June

Safeside is a child safety scheme which takes children through a variety of potentially hazardous everyday situations in a series of practical activities and workshops. It aims to involve children in exploring common situations which might compromise their safety. This is done in a controlled environment to help them discover ways of staying safe which they can share with their family and friends too.

We currently have 96 children in Year 5 so therefore the breakdown of the visit is as follows:

Coach Hire to Safeside Birmingham per visit is £375.00

Entrance fee to Safeside £6.50 per child

Total cost of visit is **£1749.00**

We currently have 96 children in Year 5 therefore the cost per child would have been £18.22

**Payment and consent can be made via PAY360 cashless system.**

**Due to the Covid pandemic when your child was in Year 3 a visit should have, taken place to the Birmingham Museum. The total revenue for this visit was £1347.50. We have decided to offset this amount for your child to attend Safeside.**

**Due to the cost of the Birmingham Museum being slightly less than this visit the cost will now be £4.00 per pupil**

If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, you may be eligible for a reduction in the cost of this school trip.

We will leave school **promptly** at 8.45 am and return to school by 4.00 pm (a text will be sent to confirm exact return time on our way back). Your child will need to bring a packed lunch which they will eat at Safe Side. The children need to wear school uniform and wear a suitable outdoor coat.

Below is a consent form and we would be grateful if you could sign and return this with to money to school as soon as possible.
